LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 1989

A LOCAL LAW FOR THE INCREASE OF FEES FOR LICENSING OF DOGS AND KENNEL
LICENSES IN THE TOWN OF HOWARD

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HOWARD AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Dog License fees for dogs in the Town of Howard shall be as follows:
A. For all spayed or neutered dogs the license fees for each dog shall be \$7.50.
B. For all unspayed or unneutered dogs the license fees for each dog shall be \$12.50.

C: For all purebred licenses; 1-10 dogs, \$50.00; 11-25 dogs, \$75.00; 26 or more dogs \$125.00.

SECTION TWO: This Local Law shall supercede and previous local law or ordinance insofar as such local law or ordinance sets dog license fees in the Town of Howard.

SECTION THREE: This Local Law shall take effect upon proper filing with the office of the Secretary of State.
